#### **Clothing:**

At Wild Adventure Camp, sometimes our adventures get messy. Campers are invited to wear whatever they feel comfortable in; we do however have some recommendations. Since we do get messy, camp is not the best place for your new shoes or clothes. We highly suggest synthetic based clothing for its lightweight, quick drying and breathability. Wild Adventure Camp brings a changing tent to all swimming locations. We also recommend old shoes that can get wet and muddy. A lot of creeks and rivers are rocky so watershoes or aquasocks are recommended.

#### Lunch:

Food is what we turn to energy throughout the day and Wild Adventure Camp is no-stop action. Having a good lunch keep us going all the way to the end of the day. Please pack a large

lunch and snacks as well as a water bottle. We would recommend avoiding high sugar snacks and suggest things like almonds or fruit.

Lunch also tends to be one of the heaviest things in our campers backpacks. Glass containers are heavy and can possibly break. Ice packs are also extra weight that the camper has to carry around for the remainder of the day. If these can be avoided your campers back will thank you.

### **Leave No Trace:**

Wild Adventure Camp practices the Leave No Trace principles. We will teach your camper the Leave No Trace principles. The third principle is to dispose of waste properly. For camp this means what comes in the lunch box goes home in the lunch box. Most of our locations do not have trash, compost and recycling so let's work together so no wrappers or plastic gets left behind!
